**Re: Response to Yukon Information and Privacy Commissioner File No. ATP-ADJ-2024-09-244**

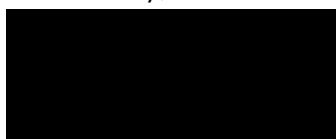

With regard to the above referenced file number, and in accordance with section 104 of the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act (ATIPPA), I write to provide notification that the Department of Justice accepts all recommendations as outlined in the Investigation Report. Specifically, the recommendations are accepted as follows:

1. The Records shall be disclosed to the Complainant;
2. The Records shall redact or obscure the faces of all third-parties who may be visible in the Records; and
3. The Records shall redact or obscure the bodies of all third-party inmates and visitors who may be visible in the Records.

As such, the Department of Justice will provide the Records in accordance with section 104(2)(b) of the ATIPPA.
