

ATP15-037AR Summary

The Applicant requested the IPC review a decision by the Department of Justice to sever a third party's telephone number from a record requested under the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act*. Justice cited subsection 25 (1) as authority to separate or obliterate the information from the record.

Following the review, the IPC found that disclosure of the telephone number to the Applicant on the facts of this case would constitute an unreasonable invasion of the third party's personal privacy in accordance with section 25 and affirmed Justice's decision.
